There is currently a fierce battle over the narrative surrounding queer people in America and many parts of the world. Books that tell queer stories are being banned. Schools are restricting mere discussion of queer individuals and families. Laws are being passed allowing open discrimination by businesses serving the general public. In Uganda, a death penalty is now in place that criminalizes assistance by queer allies. It is more important than ever that stories are told which verify the presence of LGBTQIA+ individuals throughout history. **Gayla Turner**'s is one such story.

Gayla was helping her mother clean her closet and came across boxes of photos and letters that revealed a love story between her grandmother, Ruby, and another woman in a secret queer community in rural Wisconsin more than a century ago. The realization that she was not the only queer person in her family started Gayla on a journey that took her to Wisconsin to research the people in the photos and resulted in a beautiful book, *Don't You Dare: Uncovering Lost Love*. In the book Turner tells her personal story while drawing the reader into the world of the brave community who risked their lives for love. Singer-Songwriter Johnny Schaefer was moved by the story and wrote a song, *Don't You Dare*, which has been recorded by singer/guitarist Jill Knight and included in the new audiobook. Videographer Paco Silva painstakingly restored many of the photos for a gorgeous music video. Knight's hauntingly beautiful acoustic guitar/vocal performance and Schaefer's music and lyrics provide a beautiful introduction to Ruby and her world, which Gayla's book brings to life.

This entire project is self-funded. The creative "Indie-viduals" who came together in love to bring the story of Ruby and her brave community to the world could use your help.
